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## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

These scholarships are for Pleasant Hill High School seniors planning on attending a vocational/trade school or community college focused on CTE or a similar career. The scholarships are intended to be used for the school year starting the fall of this year.

## HOW DO I APPLY?

The following items need to be completed in order to apply:

1. Scholarship Application Form
2. Transcript (the Board will reach out to Cheryl Ruiz in the High School Counseling Office to obtain a copy of your transcript)
3. Project (Video, PowerPoint, work sample, audio, pictures, letter, etc.) including the following:
  - o Tell us about your career choice. Why do you want to go into this profession/career?
  - o How will this school help with furthering your career?
  - o What is your financial need and how will this scholarship help?
  - o Tell about your experience learning to read. What is some advice that you would give to elementary students about learning to read?
4. Personal reference from a profession in your field of choice (teacher, employer, job shadow, mentor, etc.)

## WHAT CRITERIA IS USED TO SELECT A WINNER?

Award recipients are chosen based upon review of a Project that speaks to their chosen career path and how the funding will further their goals. No selfies, images of self, or name identifies should be in the project. The Projects will be reviewed and winners will be chosen by 3<sup>rd</sup> grade Title students.

## WHEN WILL NOTIFICATIONS TAKE PLACE?

Applications and Projects will be reviewed in May. Candidates will be chosen and notification will be given to the Pleasant Hill High School Principal and Counselor. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the Awards Night in June or via email.
