Elementary and High School remodel



Fall Sports

Pleasant Hill athletic teams experienced continued success this fall. The Boys and Girls Cross Country teams completed an outstanding season by bringing home the Special District 4 Championship. Freshmen Hunter Murphy won the district championship and Callan Stowell placed 3rd. The girls were led by Senior Sophie Smith's 5th place finish. At the OSAA State Championships, the Billie girls placed 7th and the boys 8th.

The boys' soccer team earned a berth in the playoffs by placing 3rd in the conference. Their season ended with a 5-0 loss to Catlin Gabel.

The football team lost their first round playoff game to Cascade Christian, 21-0.

Special recognition goes out to our Volleyball and Football teams for their outstanding achievement in the classroom. Both earned 3A Top-10 Academic All-State recognition by achieving high GPA's (Volleyball 3.68 & Football 3.01).

Winter Sports

The Pleasant Hill Cheerleading squad won the 3A State Championships.

The Girls' basketball team went 14-1 in conference play to win the MVC championship. Alix Leavitt was named the league's Most Valuable player and head coach Stacy Ermini was named Coach of the Year. The girls also had the 4th highest team GPA (3.80) for 3A girls basketball.

Wrestlers Jim Pray and Noah Casarez were crowned league champions and both took 3rd at the OSAA State Wrestling Championships.

The athletes went on to place very well in State Competition. Dana Brooks placed 5th in javelin; Madison Fisher 4th in long jump; the 4X100 girls relay team placed 4th; Austin Klecka 4th in javelin, boys 4X100 Relay team placed 2nd; Hunter Murphy placed 5th in 3000 meters and 7th in 1500; Megan Miller won State Championship in the 100 meters and placed 3rd in 200 meters; Alex Churchman was State Champion in the high jump.

The baseball team placed 2nd in league and qualified for the 3A State Tournament. They play Wednesday May 27 at Stanfield/Echo.




